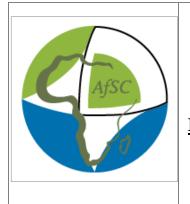


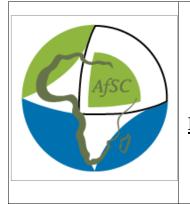

6. Young scientist nominations for IUGG 2019

7. Change statutes
It was noted that the AfSC is required to change their statutes in
order to be in line with the revised statutes of IASPEI.
This would require:
- sending the revised statutes out to the members of the AfSC for
their comments.
- reminding members that they are required to vote on the revised
statutes at the general assembly.
- advising members that should they be unable to attend the
general assembly in 2018, then they should send a proxy.
- the statutes can then be voted on during the opening plenary of
